Your plants must be in good physical condition - no wilting, no water logging, no nutrient deficiencies, no dead or dying plants.

*****Your location could be quarantined if you do not pass inspection as a result of serious problems relating to the health or condition of plants. If the problems noted

by your inspector are not corrected, you could lose your license and be prohibited from

engaging in business as a Live Plant Grower or Dealer.*****
